In 2005, Government of Bangladesh, UNDP and (DFID) launched the first phase of the Police Reform Programme which aims at improving the *efficiency* and *effectiveness* of the Bangladesh Police by supporting key areas of access to *justice; including investigations, police operations and prosecutions; human resource management and training; and strategic capacity and oversight.* The *overall purpose* is to develop a safer and more secure environment based on respect for human rights and equitable access to justice through police reform, transforming it from a colonial government order model to a public service, which is responsive to population of Bangladeshthe poor, vulnerable, women, and children.
